

**Subject: Usage of WMS data in Preventive Checks-reg**

1. Government of India is continuously emphasizing on Digital India Program with IT leverage for operational efficiency, transparency and accountability.
2. In line with the same, CWC has taken various initiatives to leverage IT usage in the Corporation. Implementation of WMS in its entirety is one of the highly important decisions to complete digitization of Warehousing Operations. The project is closely monitored by the Ministry. For implementation of WMS lot of expenditure has already been incurred by the Corporation.
3. Due to COVID 19 pandemic, physical movements are restricted & present situation may continue for an uncertain period. A decision was taken by Vigilance Division to conduct Preventive Checks online, leveraging Warehouse Management System (WMS).
4. However, while conducting Preventive Checks through the WMS Platform various deficiencies are noticed by Vigilance team. Some of the warehouses are not at all using WMS platform for recording day to day operations at warehouse level, on real time basis, despite of issuance of various instruction by MIS Division from time to time. Recently, an instruction in this regard has been reiterated vide MIS Division letter no CWC/MIS-WMS (Rollout)/2017-18/ dated 04.08.2020.

All concerned are therefore advised to ensure that the Warehousing Operations details are updated on real time basis in WMS, as the said details shall only be considered for Preventive Checks/Surprise Inspections **w.e.f. 01.09.2020**, failing to which, necessary disciplinary action shall be initiated. Non-feeding the details/information on day to day basis may be seen as an attempt to hide information/manage records. Regional Managers are requested to monitor and coordinate with the MIS Division on continuous basis.
