



Food Grains and Non Foodgrains Storage FY 2021-22




Financial Performance of CWC, Rs. in crores



% Capacity Utilization





Dividend Payout (Rs. in Crore)















 - As Covid Warrior of the Country, provided disinfection and PCS services at locations like hospitals, banks, airport, railway stations











Pest Control Services Income










Total income in Rs. crores v/s nos. of staff





 - procurement, market yard functions, Value Added Services, Pledge Financing
- Construction of warehousing complex along Railways & NHAI network
- Mechanization of warehousing operations
- Upgradation of central warehouses for conversion in Five Star facility
- Fire-fighting arrangement in the central warehouses
- Provision of CCTV (inside & outside), with live feed in public domain
- Asset Monetization of vacant land & airspace, as per Floor Area Ratio (FAR) & Ground Coverage Ratio (GCR)
